Who are the Associates of the Congr gation de Notre-Dame ?

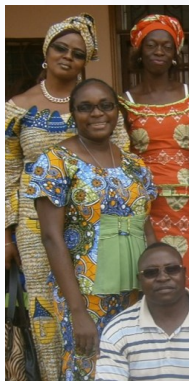
Associates are women and men committed to their baptismal call who are inspired by the spirituality and mission of Saint Marguerite Bourgeoys.
