## 2020-2021 Annual Appeal

Dear Friend,

For over 60 years Sr. Lucille Cormier, CND, blended her passions for music and for helping others. She became a CND Sister in1954 and began her service as a classroom music teacher. She then launched a second career as a music therapist.

Sr. Lucille taught at CND schools in Connecticut, Illinois and New York. While researching at the Lincoln Center Music and Art Library she discovered music therapy was a profession. She became a registered music therapist, applying her new skills first at the Hartford, CT Institute for the Blind. She then served as director of the music therapy program at Misericordia University in Dallas, PA.

From there Sr. Lucille accepted a challenge to treat special needs children at Boston's Kennedy Memorial Hospital, now known as Franciscan Children's. Her goal was to combine music therapy

and "working with children to let them know how much they were loved by God no matter what."

Sr. Lucille says special needs children bestowed on her a spiritual experience she would not otherwise have had. She found the children especially tolerant and generous. One special gift she received was to prepare Catholic children for the sacraments, adapting them to the children's needs. "Families never expected their child to receive Communion or be confirmed. I was blessed to be able to help them do that."

Sr. Lucille retired and for several years volunteered with POTS (Part of The Solution), an agency serving the poor in the Bronx. She now plans to move to the CND community at Executive House in Bridgeport, CT.

Most of the eight CNDs at Executive House are retired and no longer receive salaries. Their Social Security payments are meager. The Congregation covers these Sisters' living expenses. The annual cost for each Sister to live at Executive House is about \$20,000. Some Sisters are on Medicaid, but if they need extra services, the Congregation provides them.

Your gift will support Sr. Lucille and the CND community at Executive House. It will help sustain <u>all</u> our Sisters, whether retired or still in active ministry.

Sr. Lucille says that although the practice of religious life has changed, the core is the same. "The core remains the commitment to Jesus and the Church." She cherishes the example of compassion given by CND foundress St. Marguerite Bourgeoys. "Marguerite saw the needs of people and did what she could to be helpful to them."

If Sr. Lucille could make one change in the world and in the Church, it would be "the acceptance of differences without condemning what we don't agree with. Respect for each other regardless of different beliefs – peace, basically."
