In 1961, these Sisters were assigned to finish their degrees or to teach. Since that time, they have moved into other ministries all of which are centered in education. ## **Keeping the Dream Alive**

I is difficult to put into words our deep and heartfelt gratitude for your overwhelming support of New Beginnings. In reality you have offered a lifeline to many suffering alcoholics and drug addicts as well as to their family members, who helplessly watch their loved ones sinking deeper and deeper into a life of crippling, draining addiction.

One mother's story describes the profound pain of losing a child to a drug overdose. Today my two grandchildren and I visited the cemetery. Nathan is 7 years old and Ashlee just 16 months. We were there because Nathan had asked to see his mother. It was her 27<sup>th</sup> birthday. As I watched, Nathan lovingly wiped the dirt and grass away from the marker. He read aloud the dates of her birth and death. Like most tombstones, it summarized her life in brief lines that did not tell the full story. With sad eyes Nathan asked, "Why doesn't it say she was mine and Ashlee's mother?"

As she watched her grandchildren tend to their mother's grave, she said she could not help but wonder if Valerie would still be alive today if there had been a place like New Beginnings to help her. We'll never know the answer to that. We do know, however, that many young and not so young people are alive today because of New Beginnings.

With your prayers and financial support you are helping to keep the dream alive, a dream of a small group of committed citizens determined to restore a sense of hope to an area devastated by a human watershed of despair manifested in an epidemic of substance abuse.

Thank you again and again for keeping that hope alive. 🌻

A new problem, which touched her students deeply, concerns the cost of milk which is more expensive than the cost of soda and junk food at the local IGA! Jackie and another Associate, Gina Sader-Rubenstein, established a voucher program. Every month a check is sent to cover the cost of 100 Gallons of milk. The students have committed to continuing this program through the school. This, unfortunately, is not sufficient for the 250+ families in the area.




