
Sisters at Villa Maria Convent Rest Comfortably – Thanks to You

families to another country. They're able to express their feelings of anxiety, depression,


isolation, loneliness and fear with others who understand. Through affirmations, prayer, and being heard and seen, the women discover more about themselves.
